Foliage on the *Purple Columnar Beech* emerges a striking red in spring, turning deep purple and green in summer and fading to bronze in fall. Leaves remain on the tree well into the winter, making it an excellent choice for hedging. Its vibrant foliage draws the eye, creating a contrast with traditional greens in the landscape when planted as a specimen piece. Thrives in full sun or part shade. Deer resistant.
